Applications will be accepted on a first come, first served basis; *priority will be given to first-time campers who have not previously received services at the Children's Bereavement Center of South Texas (CBCST).* **Please note that submitting a Camp Application does not guarantee a spot at Camp Heroes.**

Before we can enroll your child/children in camp services, you will need to complete the following:

- **Phone Intake Appointment:** Intake staff will collect detailed demographic information (including custody documentation) over the phone.
- **Phone Biopsychosocial Assessment:** A therapist will gather information about your child/children, including any traumatic experiences, mental health history, medical information, behavioral concerns, and accommodations.
- **In-Person Assessment:** If risk-related concerns are identified during this assessment, we will request an in-person assessment at CBCST prior to making any recommendation on services.
